

Terms and Conditions – 12 days of giving charity donation prize draw

- Entry to the prize draw is free. No purchase necessary.
- The Promoter is Ecclesiastical Insurance Office Plc (company registered number 24869, Beaufort House, Brunswick Road, Gloucester, GL1 1JZ).
- For the purpose of these Terms and Conditions, an **“Eligible Charity”** is any charity which:
 - (a) has been in existence for at least six months;
 - (b) is a not-for-profit organisation;
 - (c) has satisfied the due diligence process requirements of the Promoter;
 - (d) is registered with one of the following:
 - the Charity Commission for England and Wales;
 - the Jersey Charity Commissioner or the Guernsey Registry as applicable in respect of the Channel Islands, or the Central Registry in respect of the Isle of Man;
 - the Charity Commission in Northern Ireland;
 - the Charities Regulator for the Republic of Ireland; and
 - the Office of the Scottish Charity Regulator;(each a **“Regulator”** and together **“the Regulators”**); **OR** is exempt from registration with any of the Regulators, but is accepted as an eligible charity by the Promoter at the Promoter’s sole discretion;
 - (e) does not discriminate unlawfully in any way, as determined by the sole discretion of the Promoter;
 - (f) does not support any specific political party or affiliated group; and
 - (g) does not relate to any controversial subject matter that is contrary to the values and expectations of the Promoter and its corporate group.
- The prizes are as follows: 120 prizes of £1,000 each (or the equivalent in Euros at the time of payment (if delivery of the Prize is to take place in the Republic of Ireland) in the form of a cash donation to be given by the Promoter to 120 Eligible Charities nominated by the Winners (as defined below) (each a “Prize” and together “the Prizes”).
- Entries must be made via the online application form available at: www.movementforgood.com/12days (“the Application”). Entrants who complete and submit the Application will be entered into the prize draw (“the Entrants”). 120 winners will be drawn at random by a member of the Promoter unconnected with the prize draw from all the Entrants (each a “Winner” and together “the Winners”).
- The Promoter disclaims liability for any damage to any person’s computer relating to or resulting from participation in or downloading any materials in connection with the Programme.
- This prize draw is open to anyone who submits an Application. All Entrants must be 18 or over. Only one entry per person is permitted across all 12 draws. Any subsequent entries by an individual, even if for a different charity will be void. Entry into the prize draw is acceptance of these terms and conditions. The closing date and time for submitting an Application for each draw is 12.00 midnight the day before each draw, with draws taking place each weekday from Monday 7th December until Tuesday 22nd December. Valid applications submitted after 12.00 midnight will be entered into the next available draw. The Promoter will accept no responsibility for incomplete or un-submitted entries. Illegible entries or entries submitted after 12.00 midnight on Monday 21st December will be void and not accepted.
- Only one Eligible Charity to be nominated on each Application.
- An Eligible Charity can only win one prize and once drawn will be removed from all subsequent draws.
- Entries nominating organisations that do not fall within the definition of an Eligible Charity, as set out above, will be void and will not be accepted. Only Eligible Charities approved by the Promoter at the Promoter’s sole discretion will be eligible to receive a Prize.
- By entering the prize draw, you hereby consent to the Promoter processing your personal data for the purposes of running this prize draw, for announcing the Winners on the Promoter’s website and social media pages and by email.
- The Promoter’s liability under or in connection with these terms and conditions shall be limited to £1,000, except that the Promoter does not exclude or limit its liability for death or personal injury caused by its negligence, fraudulent misrepresentation or any other liability to the extent that such liability cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law or regulation.
- The details of the winning Eligible Charities will be published on the Promoter’s website at www.movementforgood.com/12days every weekday from 7th December 2020 until 22nd December 2020.
- The recipient of each Prize must be an Eligible Charity and must be nominated by any of the Winners. Each Prize will be paid directly by the Promoter by BACS payment or cheque to each Eligible Charity nominated by each Winner. No correspondence will be entered into. The Winners and their nominated Eligible Charities may be contacted in relation to promotional activity. Ecclesiastical will not be responsible for any inability of the selected Eligible Charity to take up its Prize.
- Each Prize is not transferrable. The Prizes cannot be replaced if lost, destroyed or stolen or if any of the cheques are not cashed within 6 months (from the date written on the front of the cheques).

For which the Promoter shall process your personal data on the legal basis that processing is necessary for the Promoter's legitimate business need of statistical and strategic analysis in relation to the Programme.
